The Surface Water Management Agency of Clackamas County Citizens Advisory Council with Bosky Dell Natives, a retail and wholesale nursery, SOLV, and Judy Blue Horse Skelton will lead this community restoration effort to remove invasive English Ivy (*Hedera helix*) and Himalayan Blackberry (*Rubus armenicus*) from the banks and trees along the Tualatin River to prepare for native plant restoration. The newly cleared area will be vegetated with native plants this fall.



Site is at Bosky Dell Lane, heading east to the new Fields Bridge on Borland Road in West Linn. To park enter Dollar Street from Willamette Drive continue East to end of Dollar Street where it meets the river. *BYOG (bring your own gloves)*, plus a reusable water bottle and/or beverage container to minimize our 'footprint' - THANK YOU!
